Who we are

The Wildlife Rehabilitation Society of Edmonton (WRSE) is committed to proper environmental stewardship and recognizes the important role we play in conserving Alberta's native species through the services and programs we provide to the community.

WRSE is a non-partisan, charitable organization that provides compassionate care for injured and orphaned wildlife and educates the public on the importance of wildlife in our community.

Our goal is to provide a quiet and natural environment conducive to the animals healing and successful return to the wild.

WRSE has been serving the community since 1989. We annually treat over 1,200 wildlife patients, field over 5,000 wildlife related calls from the community, and provide education on human/wildlife interactions to more than 5,000 students.

What we do

WRSE supports a number of programs, each providing an essential service to wildlife and the community.

- WRSE's **Animal Care Program** provides professional medical assessment, care and treatment to wildlife patients.
- Our **Education Programs** promote awareness and understanding of wildlife through presentations to schools, post-secondary institutions, community groups, businesses and government.
- WRSE's **Volunteer Program** provides various opportunities to assist the society.
- The **Wildlife Hotline** provides information and assistance regarding injured and orphaned wildlife 365 days a year to the general public.
- Our Wildlife Hospital, located in Edmonton, provides emergency and critical care to Alberta Wildlife.
- WRSE works closely and effectively with industry, thus contaminated wildlife are brought to us for treatment and care.
